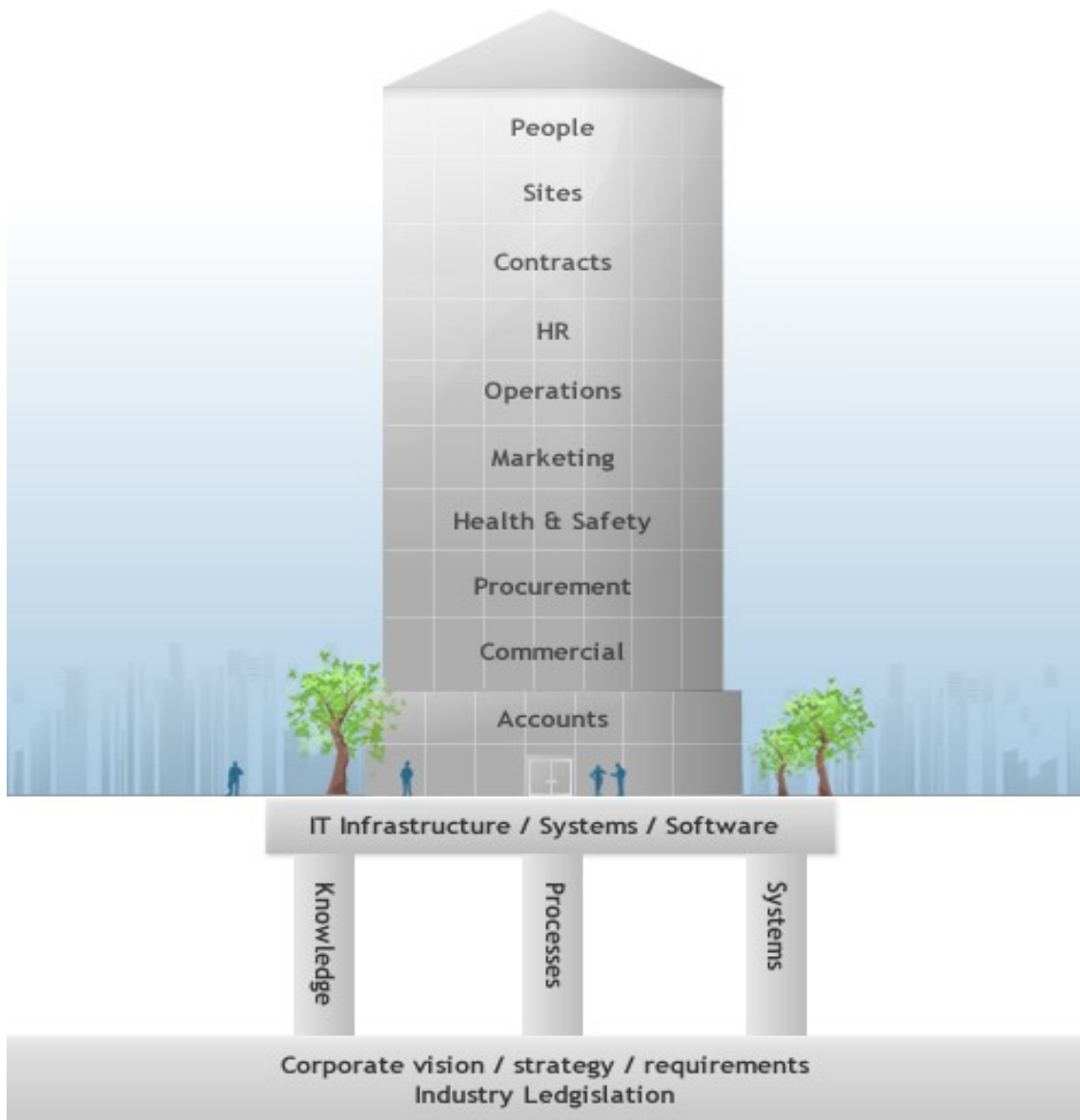


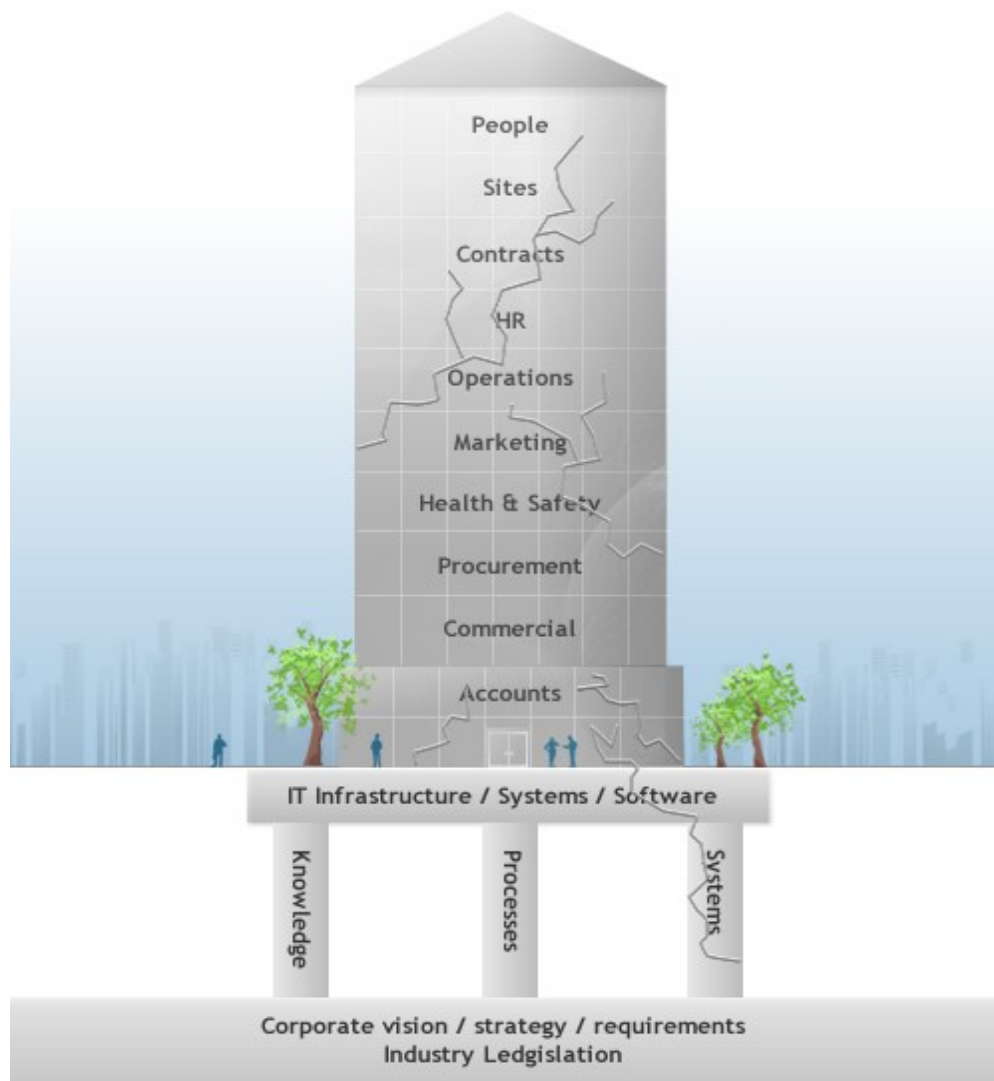
Is your business operating as it should?

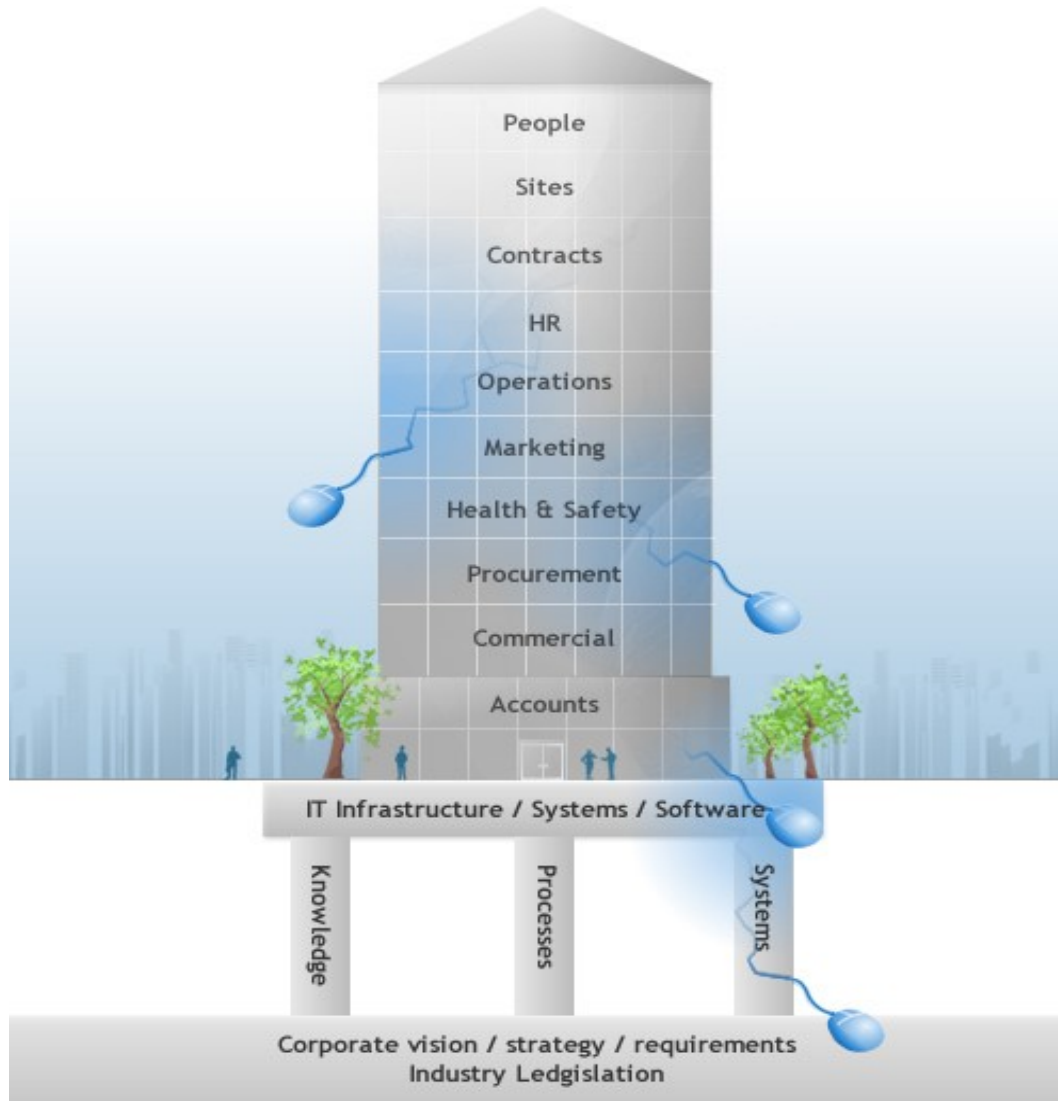
Problems with a business can occur anywhere. If cracks start appearing, just like in a building, they will often surface in the visible side of the business:
